

# Sabine Cup<sup>2022</sup>

## Description

The idea behind the Sabine Cup is to unite Sabine Skiff owners in a year long friendly tournament where each skiff owner has a chance to win a few prizes and help some kids while offering their anglers/friends a chance to win as well.

This is an honest tournament as there will not be a polygraph offered at the end of the year, so let's enjoy the friendly competition while meeting new owners, new anglers and sharing our catches with the Sabine Skiffs' followers.

Each skiff owner will enter the competition by making a \$150 donation. In return for the donation, the skiff owner will receive a Sabine Cup<sup>2022</sup> Ruler and two engraved Sabine Cup<sup>2022</sup> Yeti tumblers. The remaining donated money will be used to purchase Texas lifetime hunting and fishing licenses. Ultralight Boatworks, LLC will not profit from this activity as all proceeds will go to the licenses.

The Sabine Cup will have its own page on the Sabine Skiffs website where each skiff entered will be shown along with weekly updated catches.

## Rules

Start Date – April 1, 2022

End Date – December 15, 2022

- Participants must own a Sabine Skiff and make their \$150 donation to enter
- All fish must be caught in your Sabine Skiff
- Each fish must be photographed on and measured on the provided Sabine Cup<sup>2022</sup> Seadek ruler
- If your fish is larger than the provided 48" Seadek ruler the owner must have the approved Sabine Cup<sup>2022</sup> ruler in the photo but can use a longer measuring device as long as the numbers of inches is visible.
- The skiff owner is responsible for emailing in their tournament updated fish photographs to [sales@ultralightboatworks.com](mailto:sales@ultralightboatworks.com)
- Catch/Photo/Release
- Longest overall inches using the skiff owner's largest (3) fish per species wins top prize
- Each skiff owner can upgrade each species as many times as they want throughout the year
- All photos must be emailed to [sales@ultralightboatworks.com](mailto:sales@ultralightboatworks.com) within 7 days after the fish is caught to be entered in the tournament (no sand bagging Marsh Thompson)
- If your Sabine Skiff is sold mid-year the inches will roll over to the new owner
- No cheating, lying or fighting
- Each participant agrees to and gives Ultralight Boatworks, LLC permission to use their species measured fish pictures for all Sabine Skiff social media outlets.

## Prizes

1. Top prize for overall inches – Skiff owner's name and skiff number engraved on the Sabine Cup Trophy each year they win, Tibor Everglades Reel with the Sabine Cup<sup>2022</sup> logo engraved
2. Largest Redfish caught – Seadek Sabine Skiff door mat
3. Largest Black Drum caught – Seadek Sabine Skiff door mat
4. Largest Trout species caught – Seadek Sabine Skiff door mat
5. Largest Gar species caught – Seadek Sabine Skiff door mat
6. Largest Sheephead caught – Seadek Sabine Skiff door mat
7. Largest Bass caught – Seadek Sabine Skiff door mat

## Fish Species

1. Redfish – largest (3) redfish
2. Black Drum – largest (3) black drum
3. Trout (specked seatrout, rainbow or brown) – largest (3) trout
4. Gar (any species) – largest (3) gar
5. Sheephead – largest (3) sheephead
6. Bass (any species) – largest (3) bass
